

The Freezer Farm is for the storage of biological research samples ONLY. No hazardous chemicals, radioactive material, or other substances deemed unsafe for storage at -80°C will be permitted inside the Freezer Farm. Dry ice is not permitted inside the Freezer Farm except for the transferring of samples in or out of storage. Disposal of Dry Ice and any other restricted material is the responsibility of the sample owner. It is the responsibility of the sample owner to ensure that none of the samples transferred for storage is considered a restricted material by Freezer Farm or University standards. This attestation may only be signed by the rightful/legal owner of the samples, not a designated representative or department contact. A re-attestation is required every year that the samples are in storage.
